

EXPIRATION OF TERM

Election Board

The Chitimacha Tribal Council is seeking to appoint a Member to the Election Board to fill a term that will expire on March 1, 2030. A stipend will be provided. Interviews will be conducted with interested applicants.

Scope: The Election Board Members perform such duties as prescribed by the Election Ordinance and any additional rules and regulations prescribed by the Tribal Council.

Qualifications: All Election Board Members must be an enrolled member of the Tribe, be at least 18 years of age at the time of their appointment to the board, and must possess a high school diploma or G.E.D. Election Board Members are not allowed to be members of the Tribal Council, Board of Education, or any other elected Tribal office.

Responsibilities: Maintain all records of the Election Board. Designate dates for voter registration, filing for candidates, and the conduct of elections. Post notice of election, register votes, maintain and update voter registration records, and certify candidates. Prepare and secure ballots; set up and manage the polling place; secure the ballot box and/or voting machine; verify eligible voters; count votes; declare winners and/or runoff candidates. Report results to the public, the Tribal Council, and the Bureau of Indian Affairs. Set up and manage special elections and referendums.
