TITLE OF POSITION: HEALTH AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION TEACHER/COACH

JOB SUMMARY: Accomplishes the strategic objectives of the Tribal School by creating and promoting a flexible educational program and safe environment to learn health-related activities that can enable students to achieve success in emotional and physical health through team and individual sports. Establishes positive relationships with parents and other staff to improve the success of students in accordance with Tribal vision, mission, and values and in accordance with established laws, regulations, policies, procedures, and best practices. Responsible for overseeing the athletic department.

Minimum Qualifications:

Must possess a valid Louisiana teaching certificate pertinent to the teaching assignment. Must have a Bachelor's Degree in Elementary Education or Secondary Education with an emphasis of (24) twenty-four hours in physical education AND 5 years of coaching experience.

Additional Requirements:

- Must be able to successfully pass a background screening/investigation.
- Pre-employment and random drug screen.
- Valid driver's license is required when driving vehicles for work-related purposes.
- Must obtain first aid, adult, and child CPR certification within six months of employment. Recertification of first aid and adult and child CPR will be required annually.
