The Chitimacha Tribe of Louisiana is a federally recognized Tribe located on the Chitimacha Reservation near Charenton, Louisiana. We are a Sovereign Nation governed by our Tribal Council and our government operates similar to other governments.

The Chitimacha Child Development Center is looking for Substitute Assistant Child Care Providers to provide developmental care and supervision to assigned group of children.

EDUCATION AND/OR EXPERIENCE: High School Diploma OR GED. Preferably with six (6) months of relevant childcare experience.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

- The employee will be required to take twelve (12) clock hours or training in approved job-related subject areas per year.
- The employee will be required to take three (3) clock hours of health and safety training per year.
- The employee may be required to maintain infant, child and adult CPR and first aid certification.
