TITLE OF POSITION: DETECTIVE

DEPARTMENT: TRIBAL POLICE DEPARTMENT

JOB SUMMARY: This position is responsible for performing a variety of law enforcement duties associated with ensuring the safety and security of the Chitimacha Tribe of Louisiana. As required, it provides law enforcement services to surrounding jurisdictions. Performs as the Tribal Juvenile Officer and Detective/investigator.

EDUCATION AND/OR EXPERIENCE: Associate degree in criminal justice AND five (5) years of law enforcement experience OR ten (10) years of law enforcement experience.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be able to successfully pass a background screening/investigation.
- Valid driver's license required.
- Pre-employment and random drug screen.
- Pre-employment and Annual physical.
- Will be required to maintain vaccinations.

BENEFITS: Medical Insurance (Federal Program), Dental / Vision Insurance, Critical Illness Insurance, 401(k) Employer Match, Paid Time Off (PTO), Employee Discounts, Employer Paid Life Insurance, Short Term / Long Term Disability and Life Insurance.
