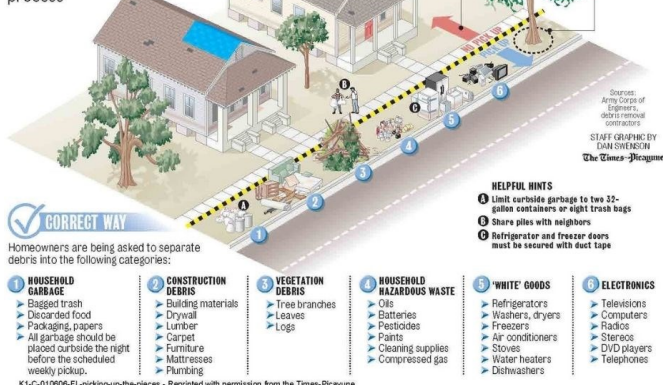

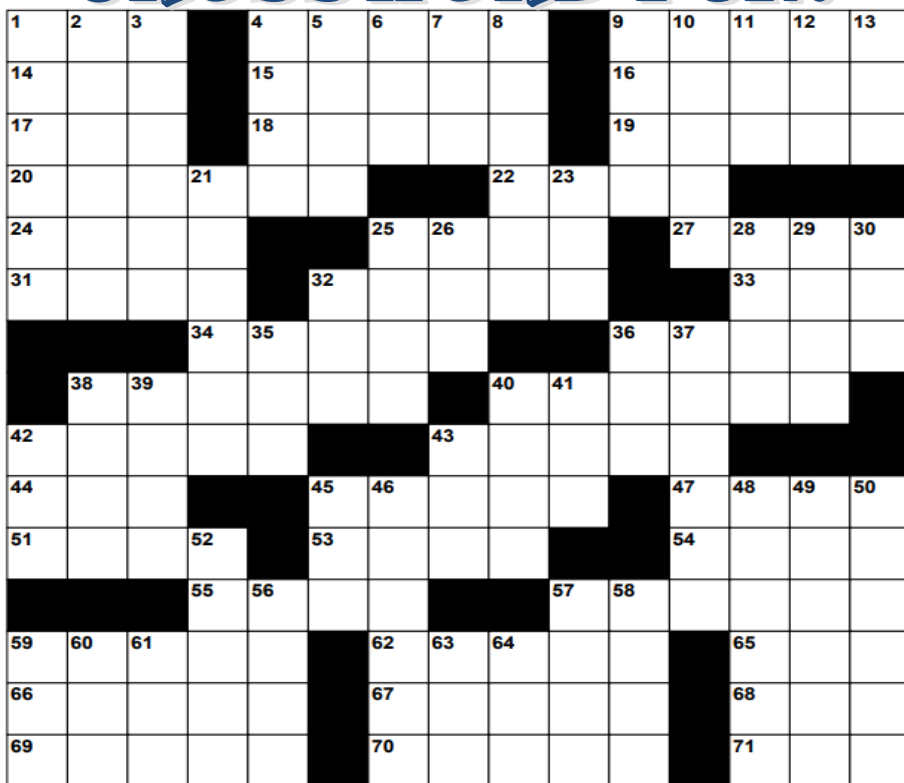
Following these specific guidelines when hauling hurricane-related debris and household garbage to the curb will make for a speedier removal process
