Full-Time Gaming Compliance Officer

REPORTS TO:

The Full-Time Compliance Officer reports directly to the Shift Supervisor.

DEFINITION:

The Compliance Officer is responsible for monitoring casino gaming operations; determining casino compliance with regulations and applicable standards; receiving complaints from the public and taking appropriate action; and related work as required.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Candidates should have a High School diploma or equivalent. Candidates must be twenty-one (21) years of age and able to pass a State Police background investigation. Must possess good verbal and written communication skills. Must have the ability to learn, understand, and apply the regulations governing the rules and conduct of authorized games, gaming equipment and devices. Must be computer literate and have ability to utilize Microsoft Word, Excel, and Outlook. Ability to deal with general public, casino personnel, and Federal and State officials. Must also be willing to travel and participate in training.
